Take a Look at your Health ID card as it Has Lots of Important Information

When you sign up for health insurance, you and your covered family members each receive a health plan identification (ID) card. Your health plan ID card is proof that you have health insurance. Health care providers use the information to confirm they are part of your plan's network and to bill your health plan for your care. Keep your health ID card handy when you go to the doctor or hospital, have lab work done or get a prescription filled (if your plan has drug coverage).
